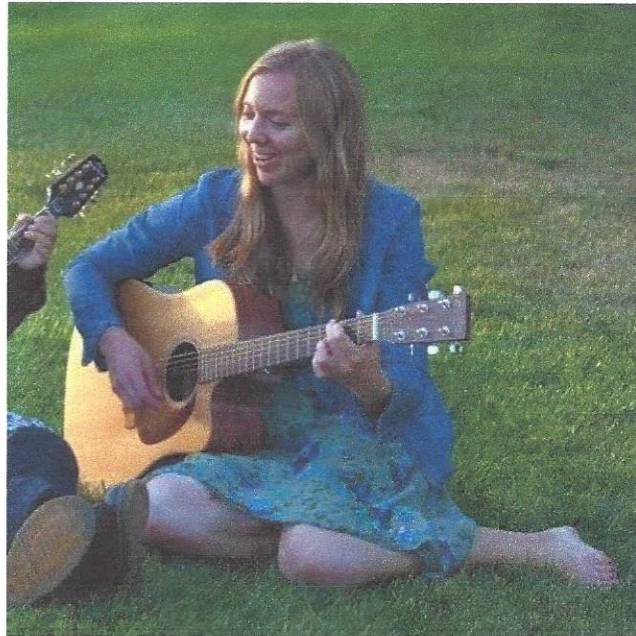


# Lauren Campfield
